IT'S ELEMENTAL

It's Elemental celebrates the talent and creativity of regional craftspeople (from Coconino, Navajo, and Yavapai counties) by showcasing fine craftwork that demonstrates a command of the medium and a high level of workmanship and design. The exhibit will include objects created from clay, wood, fiber/paper, metal, and glass. Submitted pieces can be functional or non-functional. Artists are encouraged to use this exhibit as an opportunity to show off their very best work and to stretch in new artistic directions; work that deserves to be "shown on a pedestal".

Artists may apply as an individual and/or as part of a collaboration (2 or more artists working together on a piece). Each application may include up to three works of art. Jurors will consider creativity, originality, and craftsmanship when reviewing the work. Participation in past exhibits does not guarantee acceptance into the current exhibit. **Acceptance is based solely on the images presented so the quality of the images is extremely important.**

The work submitted may or may not be for sale. Flagstaff Cultural Partners will retain a 30% commission for all sales made during the exhibit. Any work submitted for the exhibition at the delivery deadline that differs significantly in quality or concept from the juried works may not be accepted.

The 5th Annual Fine Craft Sale will be held in conjunction with It's Elemental on the first weekend in December. **** NEW THIS YEAR **** Artists may apply to have a booth at the Fine Craft Sale without having to be part of the It's Elemental exhibit. Entry into one does not guarantee entry into the other. Please see attached application for more information.

JURORS

Juliarose Tribes is a textile artist whose work has been exhibited nationally and internationally including Sotheby's New York and the Tilburg Textile Museum, Holland. In 2006 Tribes co-curated the national juried exhibition "Needle Culture" at CCA. She is currently employed full time in Flagstaff, AZ at Turrell Trading Company, the studio of artist James Turrell.

Kurt J. Meyers This New York City boy turned artist for life out the door of Columbia College, a decision cemented by close ties with the Greek artist community there. Musician, writer, aviator, sometime sculpture competition winner, Kurt has operated Flying Circus Studios for his fine woodworking in Flagstaff ever since 1977.

Jason Bohnert is a full-time studio potter and part-time instructor at CCC and NAU. Jason completed his MFA from W. Virginia University, where he had the opportunity to live and study in China. After graduate school he took a residency at an alternative energy craft studio, the Energy Xchange, where he began his pottery business JB Pots. Jason has been exhibiting and selling his work full time since 2003 and continues to enjoy teaching and making work in his home studio.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- \$35 entry fee covers submission of up to three works of art.
- A Jurors' Award in the amount of \$50 will be awarded in each of the elemental categories – wood, clay, fiber/paper, metal, glass. Additionally, each winner will have the 2011 jury fee waived.
- Artists submitting work must be residents of Coconino, Navajo, or Yavapai counties.
- Work must have been created within the last three years and created without supervision of a teacher.
- Works consisting of multiple components, such as a place setting, will be considered as one piece.
- Artwork must be ready for display, with specific instruction for any non-standard display methods.
- Insurance for all artwork during the exhibition and in transport is the responsibility of the artist.
- We will be having our 5th annual "It's Ornamental" fundraiser. Please consider donating hand made ornaments to help fund art exhibits at the Coconino Center for the Arts.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

CD (Digital Images): Up to 2 images per work of art submitted (one full, one detail). Digital images must be high quality, high resolution, 300 dpi, and in jpeg (JPG) format. The name of each file must correspond with the title of the artwork and indicate whether it is a full or detail.

- Labeled CD with digital images
- \$35 entry fee-payable to Flagstaff Cultural Partners
- Business sized SASE with correct postage for entry notification. CDs will not be returned
